



TRACE THE STANDING LINES WITH CRAYONS










PASTE THE PICTURES OF YOUR FAMILY MEMBERS AND COLOUR THE TREE

ACTIVITY 1

WASH WASH WASH YOUR TOYS!

Let's make our little ones have some fun with their Toys! Children play with their toys nearly every day, so they carry a lot of dust, saliva, and dirt if they aren't cleaned regularly.

MATERIAL REQUIRED: 3 buckets, 1 tray, water, soap, old toothbrush, Dettol disinfectant/sanitizer, cloth, your child's favourite toys, water

DIRECTIONS:

- Collect all the toys. Segregate the wooden toys (non-washable)
 & plastic (washable) toys.
- Take 3 buckets/tubs. Put soapy water in the 1st one, clean water in the 2nd one, and water with 1-2 spoons of Dettol or any disinfectant in the 3rd bucket.
- Ask the child to put the washable toys in soapy water and rub them nicely. An old toothbrush can be used to clean them. Then, transfer the toys in the 2nd bucket and rub again for a few minutes. Now, transfer them in the 3rd bucket. Dip them in nicely.
- Ask the child to remove the toys from the 3rd bucket and then cleanthe toys with a clean dry cloth and put them in a clean tray
- Now, the child should put all the cleaned toys back into their place (cupboard or rack).
- For non washable (wooden) toys, do not put them in any bucket. Clean them with a wet sanitized cloth first and then a dry cloth.
- Now, the most important part: Cleaning up the mess!
- With help, children should drop all the water in the basin.
 Then, put the buckets away and then clean the spillage with the cloth. Keep the dirty cloth for washing.

Watermelon Ice

Popsicles

Watermelon Ice Popsicles are the perfect summer treat. They are light and refreshing and makes a delicious afternoon delight for the kids. Popsicles are a great low-fat sweet snacks flavored with the natural sweetness of the fresh watermelon. You can freeze popsicles in popsicle molds or even in the standard ice cube trays as well.



Recipe:

• To prepare the Watermelon Popsicles, combine the watermelon cubes and sugar in a blender.

Blend together to a consistency of a thick juice and ensure there are no lumps. Sieve the liquid mixture if required. Add the lemon juice and stir to combine.

 Pour the watermelon juice into the popsicle molds and freeze until firm. Once frozen, to unmold the ice popsicles, dip the mold into the lukewarm water for the few seconds for easy release.

Enjoy the Watermelon Popsicles for hot summers and the kids are sure to enjoy these as treats after their play.
