Material Required: Few Jars, bottles, tubes



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Parents need to collect at least 7-10 jars, bottles, tubes (preferably empty) of different sizes having different types of lids or caps.
- 2. Parents to open them and keep the lids on one side and bottles/jars on the otherside.
- 3. Let the kids enjoy matching the lid/cap to the bottle/jar/tube and closing it. Let them analyze different ways of closing the lids/caps.

ACTIVITY 2

WATER TRANSFER ACTIVITY

MATERIAL REQUIRED: 2 bowls (One big and one small), water, tray, sponge & dry cloth.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Take two bowls of different sizes in a tray and fill water in the big bowl. Now dip the piece of sponge in water and let it absorb some water.

Take out the sponge and move it into the empty small bowl and "squeeeeeze" the sponge.

Say the word **Squeeeezzeee** while doing so. Repeat the same till entire water gets transferred to the small bowl. After demonstrating, ask your child to repeat the same.

Repeat the same activity and transfer contents from small to big bowl and so on... Emphasize on SMALL & BIG. Continue till your child is interested. Clean the spillage with the dry cloth.
